- -<u>Team Meals</u>: The game schedule has been released. We can begin coordinating sponsors for team meals.

-Other Committees needed:

- Game Day Crew for home games We need a leader for the Game Day Crew.
 We still need a replacement camera so that we have a backup. For the game day tasks, we could do a Signup Genius (chain crew, tunnel, cold spark machine, smoke bombs, camera operators). Brian Cunningham & Danielle Logue are willing to help with chains again this season!

-Fundraisers:

Car Wash/Cookout: Several coaches want to grill instead of fry, so we are changing the food we are offering. On 7/26, we need at least 5 adults to support: 2 on grills, 1 food prep, 1 collecting food payment, 1 collecting car wash payment. Aimee will do the grocery shopping. We will provide hotdogs, chips and fruit snacks to feed the players. Additional posters are needed for the players to bring in customers, especially since we can't use the ones that say 'Fish Fry'. Some of the older ones are very worn out. A

- second car wash/cookout will be scheduled likely in September. All players are expected to be in attendance. Coach A will be tracking participation.
- Caroline Logo Stencil: Ready to use. It was suggested to reach out to neighborhoods with sidewalks first (Belmont, Ladysmith Village, Pendleton).
- Double Good Popcorn: Launched on 7/15 and is doing very well. The players are being very competitive with each other. They want to win those prizes! First prize is a video game console, second prize is a \$200 gift card, and third prize is a pair of Beats headphones. The fundraiser closes after 4 days on 7/19.
- Golf Tournament 8/01/2025 at Mattaponi Springs Golf Club. It will be \$125 per player and \$450 per foursome. Valentina is still looking for hole sponsors and gift card sponsors for the prizes (Food Lion, Chipotle, Green Top, Bass Pro). Be sure to include 501c3 form when asking. -Grants:

- REC Power of Change opens in June, due by August 10th. After reading through the requirements, it does state that schools and groups affiliated with schools are usually excluded.

-Projects:

- Fall Programs We need someone to take this on. For the past several years, a couple parents have produced it. Those parents have "graduated". Leissa

- suggested Donnoven doing it as a project for school. She will look into it and let us know.
- Sound system for press box/announcer's booth? Niki pointed out how bad the
 audio is and how hard it is to hear. We can look into what it would cost to
 replace with good equipment.
- Practice & game field hazards At May's meeting, Coach Pritt brought up the
 poor condition of both fields. It is largely because there is very little rest for
 those fields so they aren't getting proper maintenance (filling holes, leveling the
 field, & keeping grass/substrate healthy). Multiple players have sustained
 injuries due to the poor conditions. We are aware of prior plans to develop fields
 down behind the football field. Work began on them, but then stopped. The
 land that was cleared has since grown back up. Can this property be developed?
 It would allow for practice field rotation and rest periods.
- Player Food insecurity no identified needs right now. We will remember to reach out to Ms. Kline from CHS, when needed. She runs a pantry of sorts out of the high school. Distribution is very discreet.
